

MEMBER PROJECT AWARD GUIDELINES

Sponsored by ADPAC, the Member Project Awards (MPA) Program serves to recognize outstanding project efforts carried out by state, local, or student alliance groups, as well as individual alliance members. Projects eligible for award consideration must align with the AADA mission statement and support one of four areas of program emphasis: dental health education, legislative advocacy, well being of the dental family, or membership development.

Consideration for a Member Project Award is based on the submission of an award application available through the AADA website. Award applications are to be completed by those with primary responsibility for chairing or executing the project. Project descriptions should provide clear explanation as to how the project coincides with the AADA mission statement and fulfills the selected area of program emphasis (projects may only be submitted for consideration within one designated area of program emphasis). Project descriptions should also identify sources and amounts of project support; both monetary and non-monetary. Pictures and written accounts of the project from alliance or dental newsletters/journals or from local newspapers are highly encouraged as they may be used for development of a visual presentation at Convention.

Award applications must be completed and received by July 1, 2017. Properly completed award applications will be reviewed by the AADA Leadership Council for evaluation and selection of awards. The recipients of Member Project Awards will be recognized during the AADA 2017 Convention in Atlanta, Georgia.
